Cebelia Crochet Cotton

Crochet Tablerunner and Napkin



Abbreviations

ch. chain

d. double

tr. treble

Ltr. long treble

Materials

- △ 90cm x 120cm Zweigart Dublin Linen colour 23
- △ One ball of DMC Cebelia No.10 crochet cotton colour 3033
- Δ One ball of DMC Cebelia No. 10 crochet cotton colour ecru
- Δ 1.50mm AERO crochet hook
- △ DMC embroidery needle

Finished size: 100cm x 40cm table runner

40cm x 42cm napkin (1)

These sizes include crochet design.

Instructions

Cut two pieces of Dublin Linen, one size measuring 92cm x 32cm for the table runner and the other 43cm x 43cm for one napkin.

Hemstitch

Mark a length of 3cm from the edge of fabric, on all four sides of the table runner. At intersections (corners), cut five to six horizontal and vertical threads and draw out.

Using your DMC embroidery needle and DMC Cebelia crochet cotton, colour ecru, hemstitch along inside and outer edges on all four sides.

NOTE: Drawing out and hemstitching on napkin is only done along the bottom.

Table Runner

Use DMC Cebelia No. 10 colour 3033 for crocheting.

For all four sides fold 1cm edge under, then begin your first row.

1st Row: 1d. into each hole. 2nd Row: 1Ltr. into first stitch, * 5ch., 1Ltr. into same stitch, miss two stitches, 1Ltr. into next, repeat from *. 3rd Row: 1d. over each chain loop with 7ch. between each. 4th Row: 2Ltr. over first chain loop, * 4ch., 2Ltr. over same loop, 4ch., 1d. over next loop, 4ch., 2Ltr. over next loop, repeat from *. 5th Row: Work over chain loop between treble (1Ltr., 7ch., 1Ltr.), 7ch., repeat from beginning of row. 6th Row: Work over chain loop between long treble (3tr., 1ch., 1 picot, 1ch., 3tr.), 3ch., 1d. over next chain loop, 3ch., repeat from beginning of row.

Napkin

Using 43cm x 43cm cut Dublin Linen, hem all four sides to produce a 40cm x 40cm napkin.

Use DMC Cebelia No.10 colour 3033 for crocheting along the bottom of napkin.

1st Row: 1d. into each hole. 2nd Row: 1tr. into first stitch, * 3ch., 1tr. into same stitch, 5ch., miss three stitches, 1tr. into next, repeat from *. 3rd Row: 1tr. over three chain, picot of 4ch., 1tr. over same, 3ch., 1d. over 5 chain, 3ch., repeat from beginning of row.
