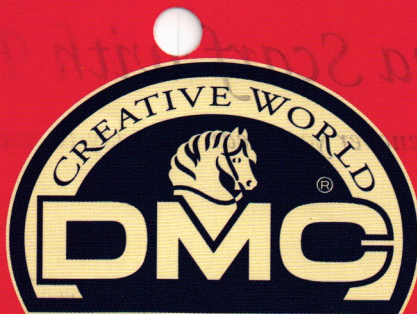

Linea Scarf with Flowers



Linea Scarf with Flowers

It will feel like spring whenever you wear this easy-to-make Linea flower scarf by DMC.

MATERIALS

Premade scarf or dupion silk measuring
50cm x 110cm, machine hemmed
1 skein each of DMC Pearl Cotton No. 5 in
814, 601, 776, 3346 & 472.
Special Carbon paper for embroidery
3 photocopies of this instruction page
DMC Embroidery Needle

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Attach 3 photocopies of the design together in a line, using the small black cross-hairs as a spacing guide.
2. Lay the carbon paper in between the fabric and the photocopied design and trace.
3. Stitch over the carbon lines using the stitches and thread colours indicated on the diagram.

BASIC STITCHES

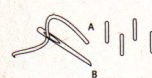
Running Stitch: Bring the needle out at A, insert at B. Continue, keeping the stitches evenly spaced.

Straight Stitch: Bring the needle out at A, insert at B. Continue, following the individual lines on the diagram to determine size and placement of stitches.

Backstitch: Bring the needle out at A, insert at B, bring out again at C. Continue making even stitches to form a continuous line.

Stemstitch: Working from left to right, bring the needle out at A, insert at B, bring out again at C (about the mid-point of the stitch).

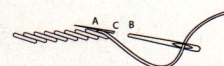
STRAIGHT STITCH
